January 13, 2025

Roberta Carter, president, called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM with all members present, except Kelsey Fleming, Kari Chambers and Seth Born. Others present: Craig Bagshaw, Superintendent; Jolene Hall, Chetopa K-12 administrator; Josh Brennon, District technology; and Terri Ross, clerk.

After removing 7.02 Donations, a motion, "I make a motion to approve the agenda as amended" was made by Josh Baker and seconded by Maggy Robison. The motion passed, 4-0.

The consent agenda included the minutes of the December 16, 2024 meeting; January bills; December VISA bill; and December activity accounts. A motion, "I make a motion to approve the consent agenda as presented" was made by Barbara Evans and seconded by Josh Baker. The motion passed, 4-0.

Under SEK reports, Josh Baker reported: student numbers continue to increase in Pittsburg; teacher shortage concern; and SEK may look for a building in Girard.

Under technology, Josh Brennon reported: Powerschool notified us that they have been hacked and information has been compromised; Powerschool is working on steps to remedy the situation; the sign in St. Paul is not working; priced signs with Vital Signs in Joplin and the cost is 30,000-50,000.

Under principal reports, in the absence of Mrs. Gillard, Mr. Bagshaw reported: new MTSS groups will be made by the 3<sup>rd</sup> week; Fastbridge testing is done; Christmas program and block the door went well; SITE council meeting has been scheduled; Harris family is interested in donating some beef; winter sports going well; getting numbers for spring sports; doing tiny tot cheer; STUCO is having a 9-12 Valentine dance; students are going to 5-mile camp soon; Juniors will take ACT; and we have a civil rights complaint. Mrs. Hall reported: Fastbridge testing is done; schedule changes are done; only boys' basketball for HS; happy with Vince Yanez's work with the JH boys and girls basketball; Mr. Yanez wants to work with the elementary; FFA will attend the welding competition on January 15; HS scholars bowl is January 16; elementary honor choir is Saturday; homecoming, tiny tot night and senior night are all scheduled; Juniors take the ACT; and administration will attend the PSU teacher interview day.

Under superintendent reports, Mr. Bagshaw reported: Chetopa library roof is still leaking on the west side; Spencer Fencing is going to look at putting steel plates on the windows on Woodaire; Chetopa students may play baseball and softball with Oswego; may need to make up the snow day as a professional development day; we have combined with Altamont for Carl Perkins funds; and had to make a change in wording in tracking data for KESA.

Under board matters, a motion, "I make a motion to extend the time frame to May 1<sup>st</sup> to validate the roof repairs were successful" was made by Barbara Evans and seconded by Josh Baker. The motion passed, 4-0. A motion, "I make a motion to work with Spencer Fencing to cover and repair the Woodaire building windows and doors" was made by Josh Baker and seconded by Maggy Robison. The motion passed, 4-0. The board tabled a motion for playing spring sports with Oswego. A motion, "I make a motion to change our snow make up day a professional

development day with date TBD” was made by Maggy Robison and seconded by Barbara Evans. The motion passed, 4-0.

In accordance with Kansas statute 75-4319, a motion, “I make a motion to go into executive session with the Board and Mr. Bagshaw until 8:10 PM, to protect the parties involved for discussion of matters related to non-elected personnel including employee performance and evaluation” was made by Josh Baker and seconded by Barbara Evans. The motion passed, 4-0.

The open meeting resumed at 8:10 PM. A motion, “I make a motion to extend the administrative contracts of Mrs. Gillard and Mrs. Hall through June 30, 2027” was made by Josh Baker and seconded by Barbara Evans. The motion passed, 4-0. A motion, “I make a motion to accept Mike Ferraro’s resignation effective May 21, 2025” was made by Maggy Robison and seconded by Barbara Evans. The motion passed, 4-0.

A motion, “I make a motion to adjourn” was made by Barbara Evans and seconded by Josh Baker. The motion passed, 4-0. The meeting adjourned at 8:15 PM.
